

Revolution is Coming Full Circle

Interestingly, the word *revolution* has been co-opted right out of its original meaning. The initial word from which *revolution* is derived is *revolve*, meaning *to move in a circular or curving course; to proceed or occur in a cycle; to focus or center on*.

The first definition of revolution is: *an overthrow or repudiation and the thorough replacement of an established government or political system by the people governed*. It is not until you reach item #4 that you read *a procedure or course, as if in a circuit, back to a starting point*. In between defining descriptions #1 and #4 are mention of social change.

How did we translate *proceeding in a cycle* to *an overthrow of a government*?

Let's take a step back and look at the basis for the reality we live in from a natural point of view. Everything in nature occurs in cycles and circles. The seasons revolve cyclically. The earth orbits the sun in a circle; so, too, the moon. As we watch the stars in the heavens, we observe the precession of the equinoxes in a circle. Ancient cultures used circles to denote heavenly bodies, halos (we still do), create theaters in the round, sit in circle to share wisdom (both awake and from dreamtime) and build temples of worship. It was not until "civilization" began to take hold that humanity proscribed to the dominant, masculine straight-edge of the square or rectangle. It is not found in nature.

Since circles and cycles are inherent within this reality. Let's take a look from a common starting point for the United States since we have to start somewhere or this article will be very long. Let's begin with the Native Americans before the white man appeared on the American shores.

The people living on the land of what we call North America lived in round tipis, sat in circles around the fire to contemplate the movements and experiences of the tribe and used the sacred circle in the medicine wheel and the Ghost Dance to invoke the Great Spirit. When the white man appeared, he changed the consistency of life by building square or rectangle buildings and erecting forts or alamos. The land moved from the circular, womblike nurturing of life to the prison or walled-in suppression of nature. While the pilgrims claim they departed Britain to be able to have freedom of worship, their tightly-held belief system became a death sentence to natural living. As the generative center of the hoop dissolved, so, too, did the connection with all things. We (in the U.S.) stem from those forefathers.

I will leave you to reflect on the other countries of the world since all peoples originated within the circle. When the natural circle became the sophisticated, manufactured wheel, the struggle over land, territory and power went from hand-to-hand combat to fully armed chariots. The chariot was originally invented by the Indo-European (Aryan) in Persia around 2,000 B.C.E. From there it spread to Egypt, China, India and Greece. By 500 B.C.E., it was *the* choice for the battle array.

While some Eastern cultures remained tied to the cyclical concept of the circle of life and death, the West (in all of its various permutations) smashed the circle out of shape. Some say "for all time". I do not believe that is true for we are coming "full circle" once again.

As we observe the revolutions (changing of cycles) in the countries of Egypt, Syria, Yemen, Tunisia, to name a few, what are we seeing? How is the circle being served and how can we (while being witness) join in an awakened, aware state with the "coming full circle" of our own lives? What does this completion of a one cycle and the beginning of another mean to you? Does it have to mean violence?

The revolving of the circle of humanity, the natural cycle of the hu – man (God – homo sapiens) is coming to the edge from which it originally came. From earthly amnesia to re-remembering, humanity's yearning to *know*, really *know* its origin is now overwhelming. It is seen in the attempt to return to the "old ways" of the circle. It is observed in the demolishing of governments that are based upon the foundations of the square and the rule. You witness this desire within yourself as you say within, "Why am I here? Why can't I remember who or what I am?"

So, I would ask this question: If you cannot remember who or what you are *as you presently are*, why do you believe that continuing to believe the same beliefs, think the same thoughts, do the same actions will take you to a new place - a place of remembrance? Obviously, it cannot, yet *it* does not have to do so. *The circle does not have to come back to the starting point in the same way in which you left it.* It can open to an entirely new paradigm by shifting its frequency (entering into a new dimension).

As the revolution of your personal cycle begins to come full circle, you will find yourself awakening to the realization that the cycle is infinite. It is not that you are going to "get there" and that will be that – just the opposite. You are going to "get there" and awaken to the beginning of your infinity. Then, your yearning will cease.
